

As a resident in L'Hospitalet, you must register in the municipal census. The municipal census registration will be useful to certify your usual place of residence in other administrative and legal procedures.

HOW IS IT PROCESSED?

When you take up residence in the municipality, you must request your registration in the Municipal Register of Residents.

WHO CAN DO IT?

- Any person over 18 years of age who lives in the municipality can request their registration in the Municipal Register of Residents.
- Any person over 18 years of age can request the registration of another person with the explicit authorization of the person concerned.
- For children under 18 years of age, the request must be filed by parents who have their custody, or, failing this, the person who can prove their legal representation.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS?

You must provide the original document, not a photocopy.

Identity document

- Valid original identity documents:
 National ID card, residence card or passport.
- For children under 18 years of age without an identity you must submit the family register or the child's birth certificate

Residence document

If there is no one registered in the property:

• The title of ownership or rental contract in force.

If there is a person registered in the property:

• A written consent from the contract holder o owner.

If you do not have a title that certifies the ownership of the property or are in a situation different from those stated above, for example, if you have no address, the City Council will check your residence:

 You must register a request together with the necessary identity documents, stating the address where you are currently living.

WHERE DO YOU HAVE TO GO?

 Citizen Care Office (C. de Girona, 10).
